**In accordance with §11-35-1560 (A) of the SC Consolidated Procurement Code, it is the intent of the SC Department of Mental Health to award without competition, a sole source contract in accordance with Regulation 19-445.2105 (B) (5) where the compatibility of equipment, accessories, and replacement parts is the paramount consideration, for the period of ending 6/30/2020 from: Aladdin Temp-Rite, US on the basis of:**

**SCDMH has been standardized for more than a decade on the Aladdin Temp-Rite system of food re-therm which is the backbone of the food delivery system to the agencies hospital and nursing home facilities. Aladdin Temp-Rite is the manufacturer and sole bulk provider of the OEM consumable supplies, equipment, and parts that are required in bulk amounts on a weekly basis by the Department. The bulk of the supplies purchased by the agency are disposable trays and serving pieces used for food delivery to the patients. The agency also purchases equipment and replacement parts for the equipment (carts, etc.) that makeup the system under this sole source arrangement. While research has found various used and refurbished replacement parts on EBay and at some part houses; none can provide the new OEM, supplies, equipment, and parts in the bulk amounts required by the agency to service the patients under our care. For this reason, Aladdin Temp-Rite is the only vendor suitable and acceptable to provide these items to SCDMH. Estimated annual expenditure is \$450,000.**

**PROTESTS (MAY 2019) If you are aggrieved in connection with the intended award of this contract, you may be entitled to protest, but only as provided in §11-35-4210. To protest an intended award of a contract pursuant to §11-35-1560, you shall (i) notify the chief procurement officer in writing of your intent to protest within five (5) business days of the date this intent to award is posted, and (ii) if the appropriate chief procurement officer has been timely notified of your intent to protest, you may submit your actual protest within fifteen days of the date this notice of intent to award is posted. Days are calculated as provided in §11-35-310(13). Both protests and notices of intent to protest must be in writing and must be received by the appropriate Chief Procurement Officer within the time provided. The grounds of the protest and the relief requested must be set forth with enough particularity to give notice of the issues to be decided. Any protest or notice of intent to protest must be addressed to the Chief Procurement Officer, Materials Management Office, and submitted in writing (a) by email to: protest-mmo@mmo.sc.gov or (b) by post or delivery to: 1201 Main Street, Suite 600, Columbia, SC 29201. Unless otherwise suspended or canceled, SCDMH will enter into a contract on August 2, 2019 for these products and services. Contractor should not perform work on or incur any costs associated with this notice prior to the receipt of the purchase order.
