In accordance with §11-35-1560 (A) of the SC Consolidated Procurement Code, it is the intent of the SC Department of Mental Health to award without competition, a sole source contract in accordance with Regulation 19-445.2105 where this service is one of a kind from: Webs Edge on the basis of:

SCDMH is seeking a sole source to highlight the Pee Dee Mental Health Center in a pre-recorded film case study within the official broadcast during the APA's Annual Meeting in Philadelphia (April 25-29, 2020). This video will profile the Center's cutting-edge mental health care services in providing expert psychiatric treatment for patients facing mental illness and addiction in northern South Carolina. The broadcast will focus on a range of topics across research and patient care in psychiatry and mental health, with a very strong emphasis on collaborative and quality care. The \$23,000 cost covers the production and distribution of a five minute segment that will be edited from 90-120 minutes of video footage by a video team. Once completed, Pee Dee Mental Health Center/SC Department of Mental Health will have full ownership of the film and additional footage for its own use.

PROTESTS (MAY 2019) If you are aggrieved in connection with the intended award of this contract, you may be entitled to protest, but only as provided in §11-35-4210. To protest an intended award of a contract pursuant to §11-35-1560, you shall (i) notify the chief procurement officer in writing of your intent to protest within seven (7) business days of the date this intent to award is posted, and (ii) if the appropriate chief procurement officer has been timely notified of your intent to protest, you may submit your actual protest within fifteen days of the date this notice of intent to award is posted. Days are calculated as provided in §11-35-310(13). Both protests and notices of intent to protest must be in writing and must be received by the appropriate Chief Procurement Officer within the time provided. The grounds of the protest and the relief requested must be set forth with enough particularity to give notice of the issues to be decided. Any protest or notice of intent to protest must be addressed to the Chief Procurement Officer, Materials Management Office, and submitted in writing (a) by email to: protest-mmo@mmo.sc.gov or (b) by post or delivery to: 1201 Main Street, Suite 600, Columbia, SC 29201. Unless otherwise suspended or canceled, SCDMH will enter into a contract on February 7, 2020 for these services. Contractor should not perform work on or incur any costs associated with this notice prior to the receipt of the purchase order.
